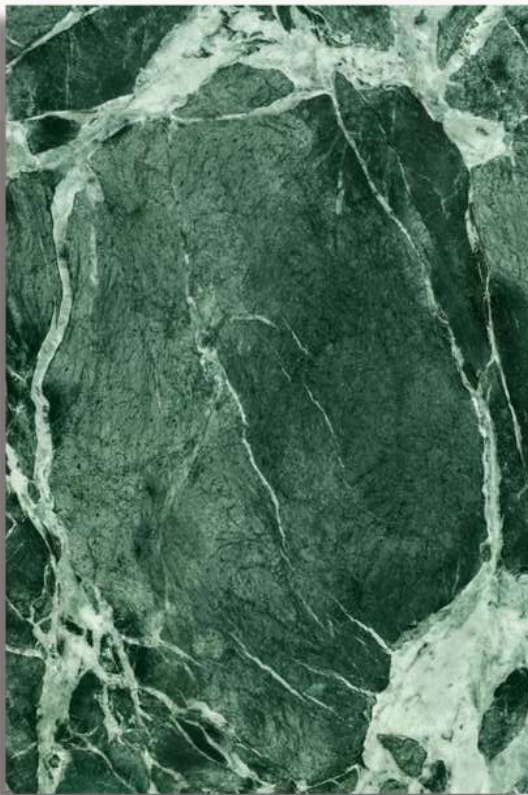
Black marble is a popular choice for flooring, wall cladding, countertops, vanity tops, staircases, exterior facades and monumental use.

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Onyx Marble

Translucency: Semi-transparent diffuses light beautifully when backlit .

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Applications:

Bar fronts, reception desks, accent walls & partitions. Translucent flooring (over LED systems), luxury shower niches, Vanity tops, tabletops, inlays and art pieces

Durability:

Softer (Mohs 3) & more porous; avoid high-traffic/ outdoor use. Sensitive to acids and UV fading.

Maintenance:

Seal every 3-6 months; clean with pH-neutral foam; protect from scratches and direct sunlight.



Makrana Marble



Makrana White Marble is one of the oldest and most iconic marbles of India, sourced from the Makrana region in Rajasthan. Renowned for its milky white texture, exceptional strength, and natural shine, it has been used in historic monuments like the Taj Mahal.

Color: The different shades of Makrana marble are pure white, white with grey shades and white with pink shades

Texture: Fine-grained, crystalline surface.



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Applications:

Monuments, temple flooring, statues, tabletops. It's timeless appeal and heritage value make it a symbol of purity and grandeur in natural stone.

Durability:

This marble is prized for its durability, low water absorption, and ability to retain polish for decades

Maintenance:

Makrana marble is easy to maintain due to its dense and durable nature. Regular cleaning with a soft cloth and mild soap is enough to keep its shine intact. Avoid acidic cleaners and wipe spills immediately to prevent stains.
